



Community Corrections Services

The Youth Service Bureau has developed services to address needs regarding clients involved with County Community Corrections agencies. Proposed services are Substance Use Assessments, Substance Use Treatment and Thinking for a Change. These services are provided in an office setting and can be individualized based on the needs of the agency and client. Cost of services for Medicaid eligible clients is available. Funding of services for Juvenile Probation Clients may be referred under the Indiana Dept. of Child Services Contract. Services for all others will be at the rates quoted.

Thinking for a Change

- Presentation of Thinking for a Change curriculum
- Minimum of 6 participants per group
- 2 hour group each week
- Approximately 16 weeks

Prime For Life

An evidence-based prevention and intervention program, Prime For Life assists individuals to reduce their risks of alcohol and drug related problems throughout life. These groups are provided twice annually and the curriculum is presented in 20 hours over the period of five weeks.

Substance Abuse Assessment and Treatment Services (Medicaid billable)

Assessments - include results from assessment tool(s) and bio-psycho-social assessment
Individual or Family Counseling - Hourly meetings conducted with an individual or with family members
Group Counseling - Minimum of 6 participants per group, hourly group each week
Intensive Outpatient Treatment - Minimum of 6 participants per session, sessions are 3 hours in length, conducted 3 times each week, each set of sessions is 16 weeks
